**20th Judicial District Judicial Performance Commission to hold  
public input hearing**

BOULDER, Colo. – The 20<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Judicial Performance Commission will hold a public hearing on May 13, 2014, from 5 to 6 p.m. in Courtroom F at the Boulder County Justice Center, 1777 Sixth Street, Boulder, CO 80302, to take input on 20<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Judges eligible for retention in the 2014 general election.

The Judges to be reviewed this year are: District Court Judge Maria E. Berkenkotter (Chief Judge), District Court Judge Patrick Butler, District Court Judge Ingrid S. Bakke, District Court Judge Andrew Macdonald, District Court Judge Judith L. LaBuda, County Court Judge David A. Archuleta, County Court Judge Noel E. Blum, County Court Judge Karolyn Moore and County Court Judge Norma A. Sierra.

Any person interested in commenting on the performance of these judges may speak at this hearing and/or provide a written letter to the commission. Only comments on Judges Berkenkotter, Butler, Bakke, Macdonald, LaBuda, Archuleta, Blum, Moore and Sierra will be accepted. Letters must include the name and address of the person submitting the comments, and the judge will receive

The Judicial Performance Commission will be evaluating information about the performance of judges to provide voters with a 'Retain' or 'Do Not Retain' recommendation for the *Blue Books* distributed to all voters before the November election.
